This contract is for 1,140 (30 gallon), 3,780 (60 gallon), and 6,171 (90 gallon) carts to be issued for the Solid Waste Services Department (SWS), Pay-As-You-Throw Program. The Pay-As-You Throw Program requires City of Austin customers to use a City issued garbage cart for removal of residential garbage. This program began in the Fall of 1993. This contract is necessary to support SWS with a reliable and continuous source of supply for the 30, 60 and 90 gallon carts. Periodically, SWS purchases carts of each size to keep a sufficient supply readily available to replace existing customers' broken carts, or to issue new carts to new customers on an as needed basis.

Toter Inc., Stateville, North Carolina is the cart manufacturer and supplier. The City has previously purchased garbage carts manufactured by Toter and found them to perform satisfactorily. Purchase of garbage carts from Toter guarantees that all components (i.e. handles, wheels, lids, locking bars, etc.) are interchangeable, thus eliminating component problems associated with items not being in stock or unavailable.

Toter is under contract with the Texas Building and Procurement Commission (TBPC) to supply these types/sizes of garbage carts statewide as a result of a competitive bidding process through TBPC. Utilizing the TBPC contract provides volume discount pricing and the earliest opportunity for delivery of the carts.

Toter garbage carts were last purchased from TBPC in February 2004 as follows:
