Temporarily closing any portion of a street for a Street Event that requires the public to pay to enter the closure area requires City Council approval under Section 14-8-3 (B) of the City Code. The applicant has complied or is in the process of complying with the requirements for this Street Event. This is the first fee paid event in the 700 Block of Congress Avenue this year. The Watershed Protection and Development Review Department has no objections to this request contingent on all requirements being met.
