**Subject:** Authorize award and execution of a 12-month requirements service contract with INTERSTATE BARRICADES & MARKING, Pearland, TX, for roadway striping for the Public Works Department in an estimated amount not to exceed \$289,265.80, with two 12-month extension options in an estimated amount not to exceed \$289,265.80, for a total estimated contract amount not to exceed \$867,797.40.

**Amount and Source of Funding:** Funding in the amount of \$289,265.80 is available in the Fiscal Year 2005-2006 Amended Capital Budget of the Public Works Department. Funding for the extension options is contingent upon available funding in future budgets.

This service contract is for the placement of raised pavement markers and reflectorized thermoplastic pavement markings on various roadways in the City of Austin. Pavement markings will be installed on over 65 miles of arterial roadways that have been newly sealcoated and/or overlaid.

All pavement markings are specified to be of Type I, thermoplastic material. In addition, supplementary reflectors mounted on the pavement to supplement white and yellow lines will be installed. In the recent past, pavement markings were applied by using Type II paint material that must be reapplied on a cycle every 9-12 months. The useful reflective service life of pavement markings can be significantly improved to an expected useful life of 4-5 years through the use of thermoplastic material.

Public Works has a great deal of work that can only be done during the summer months

(180 days). This service is necessary to augment both crews and equipment to keep pace with the current demands for striping of City streets and roads.

#### PRICE ANALYSIS

- a. Sole bidder. Other potential bidders, DIJ Construction, Inc, and Texas Parking Solution, were not able to bid because they had on going TXDOT projects of different types or did not have the manpower to do the project. b. Thirty-four notices were mailed including three MBEs and three WBEs. Three solicitations were issued with no response from the MBEs/WBEs. One bid was received.
- c. This is a first time purchase; therefore there is no price history.
