Subject: Authorize award and execution of a 12-month requirements supply contract with THOMAS & BETTS CORP., Houston, TX, for transmission and distribution self-weathering and galvanized structures and steel poles in an estimated amount not to exceed \$7,671,906.10, with four 12-month extension options in an estimated amount not to exceed \$7,671,906.10 per extension option, for a total estimated contract amount not to exceed \$38,359,530.50.

Amount and Source of Funding: Funding in the amount of \$7,671,906.10 is available in the Fiscal Year 2005-2006 Approved Capital Budget of Austin Energy. Funding for the extension options is contingent upon available funding in future budgets.

PRICE ANALYSIS

- The pricing offered represents a 68% increase to the last contract award January 2003.

The increase is due to higher costs in manufacturing steel and fuel charges for transportation.
