

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Purchasing Service Agreement RECOMMENDATION FOR COUNCIL **ACTION**



Subject: Authorize award and execution of a 12-month requirements supply contract with DPC INDUSTRIES, INCORPORATED, Cleburne, TX, for bulk liquid sodium hydroxide (caustic soda) in an estimated amount not to exceed \$131,309.10, with three 12-month extension options in an estimated amount not to exceed \$131,309.10, for a total estimated contract amount not to exceed \$525,236.40.

Amount and Source of Funding: Funding in the amount of \$32,827.38 is available in Fiscal Year 2005-2006 Approved Operating Budget of Austin Energy. Funding for the remaining nine months of the original contract period and extension options is contingent upon available funding in future budgets.

Fiscal Note: There is no unanticipated fiscal impact. A fiscal note is not required.

This contract is for an estimated 1,381,500 pounds of sodium hydroxide commonly named caustic soda. Caustic soda is used as a water treatment chemical for the demineralizers at Decker, Holly, and Sand Hill Power Plants. This chemical is necessary for the production of ultra pure demineralized water. This water is used by Austin Energy in the operation of high-pressure boilers and gas turbines to produce electricity.

PRICE ANALYSIS
