MBE/WBE: This contract will be awarded in accordance with Chaper 2-9 of the City Code (Minority-Owned and Women-Owned Business Enterprise Procurement
Program. No subcontracting opportunities were identified; therefore, no goals were established for this solicitation.

This contract will provide Austin Energy with an estimated 33 network protectors with different current and voltage configurations. The protector consists of a circuit breaker, operating mechanism, network relay, and control equipment. The protector permits two or more electrical feeders to be connected and simultaneously provide power to a common low voltage service. This is primarily used in the Downtown Central Business District. The network system is designed to provide maximum service continuity in heavy load density areas throughout the system.
