AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2005-2006 GENERAL FUND OPERATING BUDGET OF ORDINANCE NO. 20050912-001 AND THE FISCAL YEAR 2005-2006 CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT BUDGET OF THE NEIGHBORHOOD HOUSING AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DEPARTMENT OF ORDINANCE NO. 20050912-002 TO TRANSFER APPROPRIATIONS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

PART 1.
