**Subject:** Authorize award and execution of a 12-month requirements supply contract with MS TECHLINE PIPE LLP, Austin, TX, for the purchase of approximately 324 fire hydrants for the Austin Water Utility in an estimated amount not to exceed \$294,734.67, with two 12-month extension options in an estimated amount not to exceed \$294,734.67 per extension option, for a total estimated contract amount not to exceed \$884,204.01.

Amount and Source of Funding: Funding in the amount of \$98,245 is available in the Fiscal Year 2005-2006 Approved Operating Budget of the Austin Water Utility. Funding for the remaining eight months of the original contract period and extension options is contingent upon available funding in future budgets.

Fiscal Note: There is no unanticipated fiscal impact. A fiscal note is not required.

This contract is for the purchase of approximately 324 fire hydrants of various sizes. Fire hydrants are installed by the Austin Water Utility line maintenance crews and rehabilitation crews wherever there is a City water main within the City limits and surrounding areas within the City's water service area. New hydrants are installed whenever existing hydrants cannot be repaired or have been destroyed. Installation is governed by the Fire Code and the Land Development Code. In addition to fire protection, fire hydrants are used for monitoring static flowing water pressure, flushing out mains after repairs and purging trapped air.

## PRICE ANALYSIS

- a. Adequate competition.
