Subject: Authorize negotiation and execution of an amendment to the professional services agreement with LOCKWOOD, ANDREWS AND NEWMAN, INC., Austin, TX, for design and bidding documents preparation services for the 2004 Valve Replacement Program, in an amount not to exceed \$129,391 for a total agreement not to exceed \$315,391.

Prior Council Action: October 21, 2004 - Professional Services Agreement for Preliminary Engineering Services.

The City of Austin supplies water to customers through a distribution system consisting of over 3,000 miles of water mains. Valves are an intricate part of the system, used to direct, start, stop or regulate the flow of water.

During the preliminary engineering phase, sixteen (16) inoperable valves, ranging in diameter from 20" - 48", were evaluated for replacement with new valves. These valves are generally located on lines used to distribute water throughout the system. Therefore, their contribution to the quality of service provided to customers can be crucial. Health and safety, water service impacts, traffic impediments, constructability, probable cost and future maintenance were items considered when evaluating methodologies to replace the valves.

Of the sixteen valves, six will be targeted for replacement at this time. Additionally, upon replacing two of the valves, approximately 14,000 linear feet of 36-inch water main will be returned to service.

The proposed amendment will provide for completion of design phase services for six valves and the reinstatement of 14,000 linear feet of water main. A future request will be presented to Council to authorize funding for construction of the project.
