Subject: Authorize execution of a construction contract with AUSTIN FILTER SYSTEMS, INC., Austin, TX, for construction of a rock and earthen embankment dam for the Upper Walnut Creek Regional Detention Facility Project in an amount not to exceed \$3,789,966 plus an \$189,498.30 contingency, for a total contract amount not to exceed \$3,979,464.30.

Amount and Source of Funding: Funding is available in the Fiscal Year 2005-2006 Amended Capital Budget of the Watershed Protection and Development Review Department.

The Upper Walnut Creek Regional Detention Facility Project includes construction of a rock and earthen embankment dam, a low flow pipe outlet and concrete overflow spillway, modifications to an existing concrete water quality pond splitter box, installation of a new storm drain, installation of a cave gate, Critical Environmental Feature (CEF) protection, and seeding and planting at the Upper Walnut Creek Regional Detention Facility.

The proposed regional storm water detention facility is located on the main branch of Walnut Creek and is designed to reduce peak flows ranging from a 6-month to a 100-year storm event, to reduce flood hazards and to reduce stream erosion. The limits of construction for this storm water detention facility encompass approximately 20 acres including a new earthen embankment (dam) whose footprint is approximately 7.6 acres. The facility is located southeast of the intersection of Parmer Lane and McNeil Road, west of the Union Pacific Railroad, and is within the Robinson Ranch Planned Unit Development (PUD).

Flood hazard and stream erosion reduction benefits will extend to about five miles downstream of the dam (downstream of Metric Blvd.) Flood plain inundation will be reduced for 77 structures (homes, businesses and roadways).

As environmental enhancements, the project includes maintaining and vegetating an existing wetland and re-foresting an existing detention pond in the project area (approximately five acres) with native trees.

Due to the potential for unknown subsurface conditions, a 5% contingency in funding has been included to allow for the expeditious processing of any future change orders. The contract allows 365 calendar days for completion of this project.

Bid documents were distributed to five general contractors. Bids were opened May 25, 2006. Austin Filter Systems, Inc. submitted the lower of two bids received:



The contractor's choice of work methodology provides for subcontracting opportunities in nine areas which are listed below. Project specific subgoals stated in the solicitation were 5.44% African American (MB); 13.40% Hispanic (MH); 0.00% Native American (MN); 0.32% Asian Americans (MA); 5.80% WBE.
