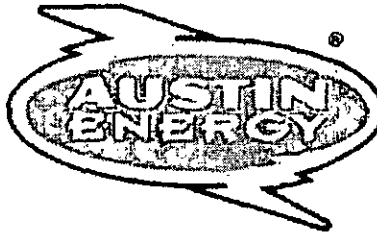

MBE/WBE: This contract was awarded in compliance with Chapter 2-9D of the City Code (Minority-Owned and Women-Owned Business Enterprise Procurement Program). No subcontracting opportunities were identified; therefore, no goals were established for this solicitation.

Prior Council Action: May 25, 2006, by Resolution No.
20060525-051

This contract is to purchase power transformers to be used throughout the various substations in the Austin Energy Service Area. This type of large transformer is used to convert power delivered by the City's transmission system from 138,000 volts to the distribution level of 12,470 volts.

Due to several unplanned substation additions, Austin Energy needs additional funding to purchase four additional transformers. These transformers will cover the addition of two transformers at the Dessau Substation to accommodate Samsung's new February 2007 expansion and two transformers to the new substation near Wells Branch to accommodate a new Hewlett Packard data center. The Austin Energy General Manager approved a Critical Business Need on June 2, 2006 for this purchase in order to meet the required delivery and installation deadlines.

SUBJECT: Ratification of Contract with Hyundai Corp. for Increased Spending Authorization for Power Transformer Supply Agreement, as a Critical Business Need


BACKGROUND:

Due to several new customer driven substation additions this year and next, Austin Energy (AE) needs to increase the authorized spending amount on contract C060081, with Hyundai Corp. for the current contract year (February 1, 2006 through January 31, 2007), from \$3,034,480 to \$6,484,480, an increase of \$3,450,000 for the initial term. This increase will provide the spending flexibility to cover the purchase of four additional transformers that were not anticipated when the original request was submitted. The four additional transformers will cover the addition of two transformers at the Dessau substation to accommodate Samsung's new Fab 2 expansion, and to a new substation near Wells Branch to accommodate a new Hewlett Packard data center.

RESOLUTION:

Our current project schedule requires that AE issues purchase orders immediately to meet the required delivery date for the Wells Branch transformers. For this reason, I have authorized AE to expedite this item as a critical business need. This action is in accordance with the critical business need provision of the AE Purchasing Procedures adopted by the City Council. We will submit an RCA for ratification of this action on July 27, 2006.
