Subject: Approve an ordinance authorizing acceptance of \$43,000 in grant funds from the United States Housing and Urban Development Department for compliance with the Fair Housing Act and amending the Fiscal Year 2005-2006 Human Resources Department Operating Budget Special Revenue Fund of Ordinance No. 20050912-001 to appropriate \$43,000 in grant funds.

Amount and Source of Funding: Funding of \$43,000 is available from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development. The grant period is October 1, 2005-September 30, 2006. An in-kind match is not required. A fiscal note is attached.

Title VIII of the Civil Rights Act of 1968 as amended, known as the Fair Housing Act, prohibits discrimination in the sale, rental, and financing of housing based on race or color, national origin, religion, sex, familial status and disability. The Equal Employment/Fair Housing Office, located in the Human Resources Department, has been designated by HUD as a FHAP (Fair Housing Assistance Program) agency to identify, file, and investigate complaints of housing discrimination in the City of Austin. The U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) reimburses the City of Austin for work conducted by the Equal Employment/Fair Housing Office.

In light of the housing needs of persons displaced by Katrina and Rita, HUD designated the Equal Employment/Fair Housing Office and Austin Tenants' Council, Inc. as partners to jointly provide Fair Housing education campaign in the City of Austin, to raise the public's awareness of civil rights regarding fair housing, and specifically for outreach campaign for persons displaced by Katrina and Rita of their Fair Housing rights and responsibilities. One-time funding was added for this partnership endeavor.

In FY 06, HUD opened the National Fair Housing Training Academy in Washington, D.C. All FHAP personnel were required to go through a series of training provided by the Academy within a specified time frame. Initially, training funds were retained by HUD for direct payments to the Academy. HUD later decided to disperse training funds to the FHAP.

Performance Measure(s): • Percentage of contract requirement fulfilled as required by contract (100%)

Requested Action:

Council is requested to amend the FY2005-06 Operating Budget by accepting and appropriating an additional \$43,000 in grant funds for the Human Resources Department's Fair Housing Act Compliance grant.

Contingency Plan:

The partnership with Austin Tenants' Council, Inc. will cease if funding is eliminated. The Academy training funds will continue to be part of the grant reimbursement.
