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Public Works RECOMMENDATION FOR COUNCIL ACTION

ITEM No. 27

Subject: Authorize negotiation and execution of an amendment to the professional services agreement with CARTER DESIGN ASSOCIATES, (MBE/FB 24%), Austin, TX, for design phase architectural and engineering services for interior renovation of the George Washington Carver Historic Museum in the amount of \$15,850, for a total contract amount not to exceed \$1,163,694.

Amount and Source of Funding: Funding in the amount of \$15,850 is available in the Fiscal Year 2005-2006 Approved Capital Budget of the Parks and Recreation Department.

George Washington Carver Historic Museum Renovation was not a part of the 1998 bond election. There are remaining Capital Improvement Project contingency funds from the 1998 voter approved new Museum and Cultural Center expansion project that would provide an opportunity to renovate the historic museum. Prior to the opening of the new Museum and Cultural Center on the campus at 1165 Angelina Street, all activities of the museum were carried out from the historic museum. The historic museum was vacated after the opening. It is a desire of the community to turn this historic building into a genealogy center. Exterior and interior renovations will be done as two separate projects since funding for construction of interior renovations is not available.

This amendment allows for Schematic Design and Design Development phase services for interior changes and modifications to convert the building to a genealogy center. The design work will include an accessible restroom, new lighting, new finishes, offices and conference room for research use. The work also includes a cost estimate to complete the interior renovations.

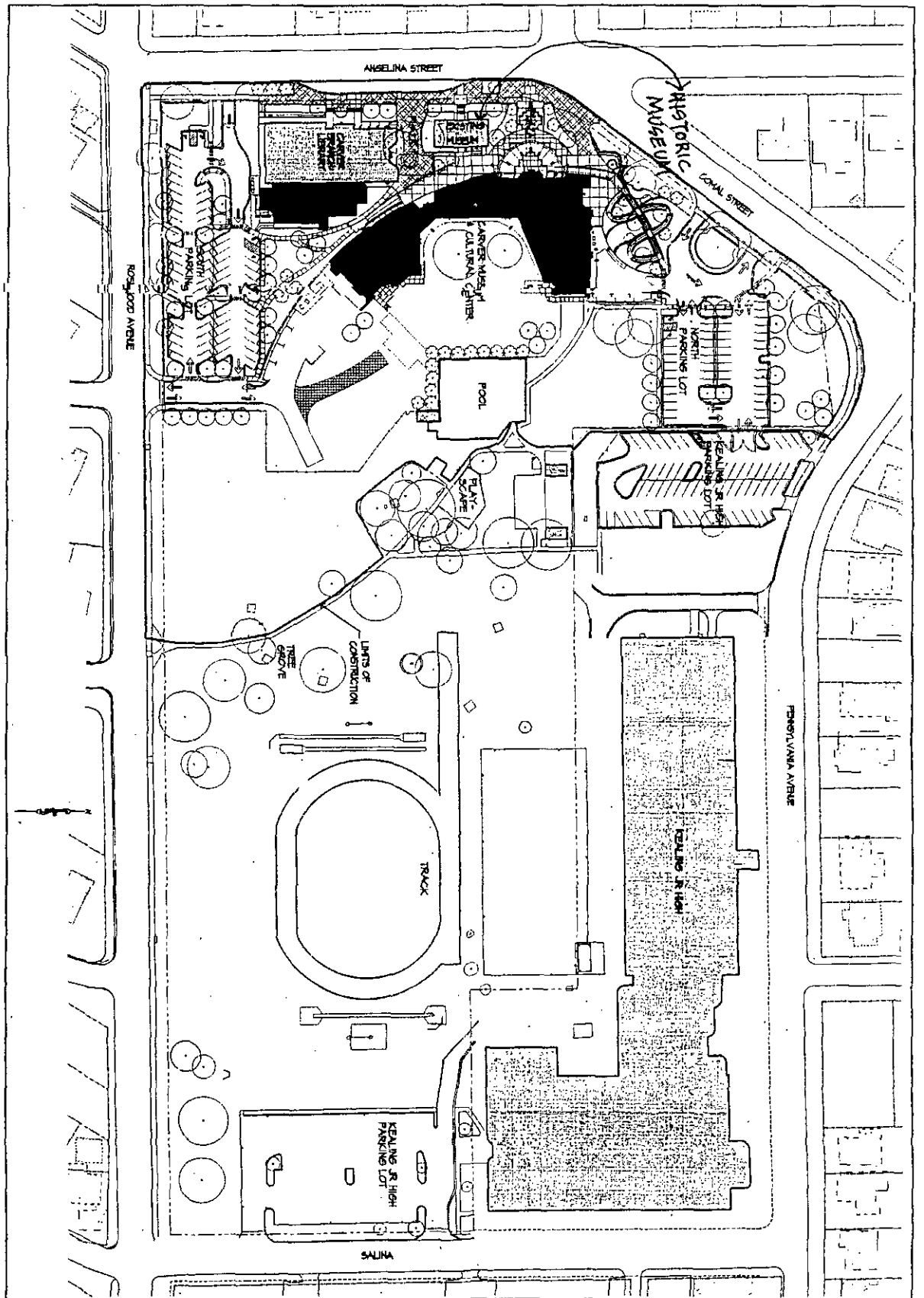
