This contract amendment will extend performance and funding for the period of September 1, 2006 through December 31, 2006 for the Texas Exile Program. The Texas Exile Program supports Project Safe Neighborhood (PSN) and provides an Assistant District Attorney (ADA) dedicated to the prosecution of crimes involving the unlawful use or possession of firearms. The program is in cooperation with the Austin Police Department and the Office of the United States Attorney for the Western District of Texas. The PSN ADA is also designated as Special Assistant United States Attorney for the United States Federal District Courts for the Western District of Texas. The current interlocal agreement ends on August 31, 2006 and must be extended in order to continue the program and to expend \$40,786 in supplemental grant funding through December 2006.

This agreement is entered into under the provisions of the Interlocal Cooperation Act, Chapter 791, Texas Government Code.
