RESOLUTION NO.

WHEREAS, by Resolution dated June 22, 2006 the City Council directed the City Manager to implement water conservation measures with a goal of reducing peak day usage by one percent per year for 10 years; and

WHEREAS, to meet the goal will require consideration of alternative strategies and policies; **NOW, THEREFORE**,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

The Water Conservation Implementation Task Force is hereby created.

The objective of the task force is to produce a policy document for City Council consideration no later than 90 days following the task force's first meeting. The policy document will outline strategies and implementation plans and will serve as a guideline for drafting necessary code and rule amendments.
