Subject: Authorize execution of a construction contract with SOUTHWEST CORPORATION, Austin, TX, for Austin City Store improvements in an amount not to exceed \$257,981.

Amount and Source of Funding: Funding in the amount of \$181,873 is available in the Fiscal Year 2005-2006 Approved Operating Budget of the Economic Growth and Redevelopment Services Office, Special Revenue Fund City Hall Retail Tenant Improvements and \$76,108 is available in the Fiscal Year 2005-2006 Approved Operating Budget of the Economic Growth and Redevelopment Services Office.

Purchasing Language: Lowest of two bids received.

MBE/WBE: 17.34% MBE and 0.25% WBE subcontractor participation.

The Austin City Store, a new retail venture for the City of Austin, will occupy approximately 1,435 square feet on the first floor of City Hall at the northwest corner along 2nd Street. The store will be operated by the Convention Center Department and will sell products that positively promote City services and the Austin community. Locally created artwork, jewelry and clothing will also be available through rotating consignment agreements with local artisans. It is anticipated the store will be open in December 2006.

The design of the store is similar to a museum store and includes specific materials and waste management requirements for the City to achieve a Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design (LEED) Silver Certification from the U. S. Green Building Council, under the Commercial Interiors standards. The work consists of the installation of flooring, lighting, heating and air conditioning, painting, millwork and display units and shelving. A signage allowance of \$10,000 is also included in the construction contract for a total construction amount of \$257,981. The contract allows 75 calendar days for completion of this project.

Bid documents were distributed to five general contractors. Bids were opened August 15, 2006. Southwest Corporation submitted the lower of two bids received:

The contractor's choice of work methodology provides for nine areas of subcontracting opportunities: drywall, painting, flooring, concrete, mechanical, electrical, millwork, fire sprinkler systems and cleaning.

Participation sub goals stated in the solicitation were: 11.16% MBE and 5.74% WBE. Total participation estimated on base bid amount of \$247,981.00:
