setting the date to conduct the public hearing and adopt the Fiscal Year 2006-2007 ad valorem tax rate.

This action requests the City Council to conduct a public hearing to receive comments on the proposed ad valorem tax rate for Fiscal Year 2006-2007.

On August 10, 2006, the City Council voted to adopt 41.26 cents per \$100 valuation as the maximum proposed ad valorem tax rate it will consider adopting for Fiscal Year 2006-2007.

The actual tax rate adopted by the City Council after its budget deliberations may be lower than 41.26, but it will not be higher.

This is the second of two public hearings to consider the proposed ad valorem tax rate, as required by State truthin-taxation laws. The first public hearing was held on Thursday, August 24, 2006. This public hearing will be held at City Hall Council Chambers, 301 West 2nd Street, at 6:00 p.m.

The City Council is scheduled to adopt the Fiscal Year 2006-2007 ad valorem tax rate on Monday, September 11, 2006, on Tuesday, September 12, 2006, or on Wednesday, September 13, 2006, at City Hall Council Chambers, 301 West 2nd Street, at 6:00 p.m..
