AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING FEES, FINES, AND OTHER CHARGES TO BE CHARGED BY CITY DEPARTMENTS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2006-2007 BEGINNING ON OCTOBER 1, 2006, AND ENDING ON SEPTEMBER 30, 2007.

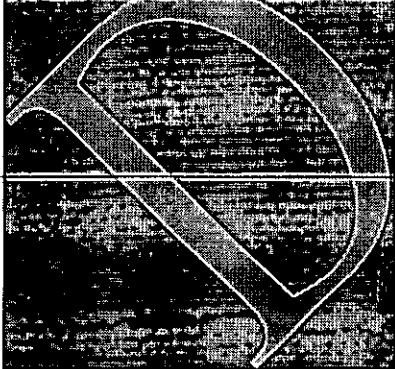
BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

PART 1. The City Council authorizes the fees, fines and other charges listed in the attached Exhibit "A" to be charged by the various City departments for Fiscal Year 2006-2007 beginning on October 1, 2006, and ending on September 30, 2007.

PART 2. To the extent that a previous ordinance conflicts with this ordinance, the earlier ordinance is repealed.

PART 3. Except as otherwise specifically provided in Exhibit "A," this ordinance takes effect on October 1, 2006. A fee, fine or other charge for which a specific effective date has been established in Exhibit "A" takes effect on the specified effective date.
