

## AUSTIN CITY COUNCIL MINUTES

## ANNEXATION SPECIAL CALLED MEETING MONDAY, AUGUST 14, 2006

The City Council of Austin, Texas, convened in a Special Called Meeting on Monday, August 14, 2006 at the Westlake High School, Fine Arts Facility, 4100 Westbank Drive, Austin, Texas.

Mayor Wynn called the Council Meeting to order at 6:50 p.m.

The motion to waive the rules and allow Council to meet after 10 p.m. was approved on Council Member McCracken's motion, Council Member Martinez' second on a 7-0 vote.

1. Conduct a public hearing to receive comments on issues related to the full purpose annexation of the Lost Creek MUD annexation area (approximately 789 acres in Travis County, located west of Capital of Texas Highway, west of the intersection of Lost Creek Boulevard and Capital of Texas Highway.) Full purpose annexation is anticipated in December 2008 in accordance with the City's Municipal Annexation Plan.

The public hearing was closed on Council Member Leffingwell's motion, Council Member McCracken's second on a 7-0 vote.

Mayor Wynn adjourned the meeting at 10:42 p.m. without objection.
