



Prior Council Action: 11/29/01 - Selection of Turner Collie & Braden and funding authorization for preliminary engineering; 9/26/02 authorization and funding for design phase services for the Northeast WWTP; 6/12/03 authorization and funding for additional design services due to moving Northeast WWTP site to Wildhorse Ranch including the Wildhorse North Interceptor; 2/19/04 authorization and funding for construction/warranty phase services and design services for the Gilleland Creek Interceptor; 12/01/05 authorization and funding for additional construction phase services for the Northeast WWTP and archeological investigations and easement procurement assistance related to the Gilleland Creek Interceptor.

The Austin Water Utility has completed the first phase of providing regional wastewater service to the Northeast service area per the Northeast Area Wastewater Service Master Plan and in accordance with the Inter-local Agreement executed September 30, 2002, between the City of Austin and the City of Manor. Presently, the Northeast Wastewater Treatment Plant and the Wildhorse North Interceptor are complete and in service, and the old Manor Wastewater Treatment Plant has been decommissioned. In June 2003, the Council directed the Utility to complete design of an interceptor extension, known as the Gilleland Creek Interceptor, which branches off the Wildhorse North Interceptor and extends in a northerly direction and terminates on the north side of Highway 290. The Gilleland Creek Interceptor will be the connection point that will serve wastewater customers north of Hwy 290 and on both sides of Gilleland Creek. During the course of the design, extensive coordination was conducted between all parties including the consultant team, the Austin Water Utility, Real Estate Services, various developers, and the City of Manor in an effort to best meet the service needs of current and future customers in the Northeast area.

Specifically, this request is for authorization of additional funding for modification of the Gilleland Creek Interceptor design and routing required as a result of planned development along the Hwy 290 corridor. Recently a developer has submitted plans to the City of Manor for a large commercial retail complex located adjacent to the Manor ISD middle school. The location of this commercial complex conflicts with the currently designed routing of the Gilleland Creek Interceptor, thus necessitating rerouting a portion of the interceptor and making design changes to accommodate connection. This will also require additional surveying, modification of easement documents, continued assistance with easement procurement, further coordination with the developers and the City of Manor. Also, this authorization includes funding for bid phase services for the selection of a contractor to construct the Gilleland Creek Interceptor.
