ITEM No. 32

Subject: Authorize execution of a construction contract with BARECKY CONSTRUCTION COMPANY, Wimberley, TX, for the Gustavo "Gus" L. Garcia Recreation Center in an amount of \$6,252,496 plus a \$312,624 contingency, for a total contract amount not to exceed \$6,565,120.

Amount and Source of Funding: Funding in the amount of \$6,565,120 is available in the Fiscal Year 2005-2006 Approved Capital Budget of the Parks and Recreation Department.

Prior Council Action: 06-19-00 Park and Building Naming Ordinance; 08-10-01 Consultant Selection; 08-26-04 Competitive Sealed Proposal Process Approval.

The Gustavo "Gus" L. Garcia Recreation Center will provide a recreation center to the neighborhood in Northeast Austin. With the award of the contract, construction should start in October 2006 and be completed by October 2007.

The contract amount includes Alternate No. 1 - the inclusion of a maple wood floor system in the gymnasium, Alternate No. 2 - the inclusion of Bermuda grass hydromulch and a temporary irrigation system. The construction of this new building located in the Gustavo "Gus" L. Garcia Neighborhood Park will provide the following spaces: classrooms, computer room, offices, storage areas, restrooms, locker room, shower areas and a gymnasium. The contract allows 325 calendar days for completion of the project.

Due to the potential for unknown subsurface conditions, utility conflicts when working in the right-of-way, and the number of construction trades involved a 5% contingency in funding has been included to allow for the expeditious processing of any future change orders.

As approved by Council on August 26, 2004, the project was solicited as a Competitive Sealed Proposal. Proposal documents were distributed to five general contractors and proposals were received on June 22, 2006. As part of the Competitive Seal Proposal procurement method, evaluation criteria were given to the contractors as part of the construction documents. The construction company was selected based on these criteria, with cost being one of the consideratin items.

Barecky Construction Company was selected as providing the best proposal of the two proposals received.


