<u>SUBJECT</u>: Approve a resolution amending the Fiscal Year 2006-2007 Grant Operating Budget of Resolution No. 20060911-AHFC001 to increase the Grant Operating Budget by \$2,552,153 for a total of \$14,454,256 and a total Fiscal Year 2006-2007 budget of \$15,221,882.

AMOUNT & SOURCE OF FUNDING: Funding in the amount of \$1,552,153 is available in the Fiscal Year 2006-2007 General Fund Operating Budget of Neighborhood Housing and Community Development and \$1,000,000 is available in the S.M.A.R.T. Housing TM Capital Improvement Fund.

This action amends the Fiscal Year 2006-2007 Austin Housing Finance Corporation (AHFC) Grant Operating Budget in an amount of \$2,552,153 to reflect additional amounts available to AHFC under the annual service agreement with the City of Austin.

The Austin City Council created the Austin Housing Finance Corporation in 1979 as a public non-profit corporation to facilitate the financing and development of affordable S.M.A.R.T. Housing TM for low and moderate-income residents. AHFC offices are located in the Neighborhood Housing and Community Development department and its employees are City of Austin staff. As an instrumentality of the City, the AHFC administers affordable housing programs using City grants, federal grant funds from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD), the City's Housing Trust Fund, funds generated by the Corporation and an annual transfer from the AHFC Housing Assistance Fund.
