RECOMMENDATION FOR COUNCIL ACTION

ITEM No. 12

Subject: Authorize execution of a construction contract with MUNIZ CONCRETE AND CONTRACTING, INC., (MBE/MH 89.54%), Austin, TX, for ADA Sidewalk and Ramp Improvements 2007 City Wide Group 5 in the amount of \$3,517,197.25 plus a \$351,719.72 contingency, for a total contract amount not to exceed \$3,868,916.97.

Amount and Source of Funding: Funding in the amount of \$3,868,916.97 is available in the Fiscal Year 2006-2007 Capital Budget of the Public Works Department.


MBE/WBE: 6.03% MBE and 4.44% WBE subcontractor participation.

As part of the City's ongoing effort to comply with the directives of the Federal Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA), the Public Works Department has developed more efficient and cost effective methods for sidewalk and curb ramp construction. The City also recognizes that improved and expanded pedestrian facilities are also a frequently requested infrastructure improvement from the public at large. The projects proposed for construction under this initiative have been previously approved by one of the following methods: Council approval of proposed CMTA ¼ cent projects, Build Greater Austin projects, ADA Task Force projects, Child Safety program sidewalks, and 1998 and 2000 Bond funded neighborhood sidewalks.

The construction method chosen to deliver the initiatives is an Indefinite Delivery/Indefinite Quantity (IDIQ) contract. The IDIQ contract documents include engineered details and specifications; project locations currently identified, and estimated total quantities of work. As each project location is further defined, a specific "work assignment" is given to the contractor and they will complete the scope of work for the unit prices included in the contract. This contracting method also allows for the flexibility of adding projects based on priorities designated by the City.

The purpose of the contract is to have a contractor available to complete pedestrian and accessibility projects on a unit price basis. The projects are located through out the City. The contract is for an estimated period of one year. Each work assignment must be finally completed within the duration established by the owner for each assignment. The owner will consult with the contractor on each assignment's duration, but the owner will have ultimate discretion on duration which shall not be unreasonably stipulated.

Due to the potential for unknown subsurface conditions and utility conflicts when working in the right-of-way, a 10% contingency in funding has been included to allow for the expeditious processing of any future change orders.



Bid documents were distributed to four general contractors. Bids were opened August 31, 2006. Muniz Concrete and Contracting, Inc. submitted the only bid received.

The contractor's choice of work methodology provides for three areas of subcontracting opportunities: Demolition/excavation, fuel supply and signs/barricades.

Project specific subgoals stated in the solicitation were 6.84% African American; 16.79% Hispanic; 2.17% Asian/Native American; and 5.90% WBE. Total participation estimated on base bid amount of \$3,517,197.25:
