\$ 2,721	Total fees waived

In summary, total fees waivers are \$2,721.

As outlined in Resolution No. 021003-40, Mayor Pro Tem Dunkerley has agreed to apply \$907.00 to her fee waiver allocation budget, Council Member Leffingwell has agreed to apply \$907.00 to his fee waiver allocation budget, and Council Member McCracken has agreed to apply \$907.00 to his fee waiver allocation budget.

Although budgeted revenue for fees is based upon historical data and not necessarily upon specific events, the waiver of these fees reduces potential revenues that could be realized.
