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
Purchasing Office RECOMMENDATION FOR COUNCIL ACTION

ITEM No 27

Subject Authorize award and execution of a 24-month requirements supply agreement with CALABRIAN CORPORATION, Lisle, IL, to provide liquid sulfur dioxide for the Austin Water Utility in an estimated amount not to exceed \$193,520, with two 12-month extension options in an estimated amount not to exceed \$120,950 for the first extension option and \$151,187 for the second extension option, for a total estimated contract amount not to exceed \$465,657

Amount and Source of Funding Funding in the amount of \$96,760 is available in the Fiscal Year 2006-2007 Operating Budget of the Austin Water Utility Funding for the remaining 12 months of the original contract period and extension options will be contingent upon available funding in future budgets

Fiscal Note There is no unanticipated fiscal impact. A fiscal note is not required

Purchasing Language Low bid of two bids received

MBE/WBE This contract will be awarded in compliance with Chapter 2-9D of the City Code (Minority-Owned and Women-Owned Business Enterprise Procurement Program) No subcontracting opportunities were identified, therefore no goals were established for this solicitation

This contract is for the supply of liquid sulfur dioxide in 1-ton containers. The Austin Water Utility uses sulfur dioxide to remove chlorine from wastewater effluent following the disinfection treatment process. The requested agreement will help insure the City remains in compliance with State and Federal Discharge Compliance Monitoring Regulations. Liquid sulfur dioxide will be purchased on an as needed basis for delivery to and use at the Walnut Creek and South Austin Regional Wastewater treatment plants.
