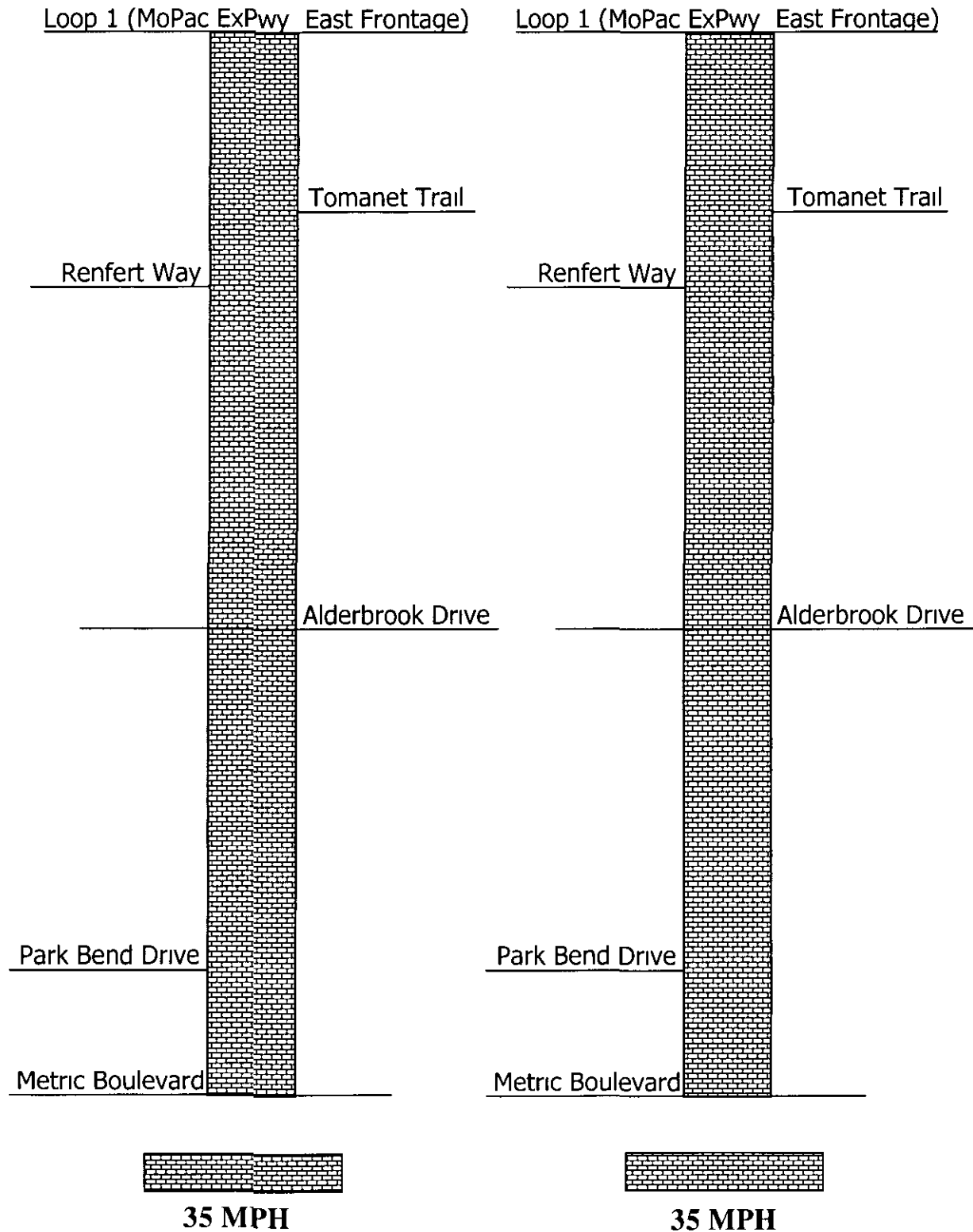
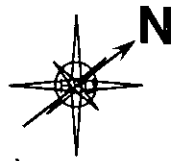
To modify or alter the existing prima facie speed limit of a street, the Texas Traffic Laws require that a traffic engineering investigation be performed. A review of our records revealed that an engineering study could not be found to support the posted speed limit. As a result, an investigation was conducted by the Public Works Department in accordance with the procedures specified in the Texas Procedures for Establishing Speed Zones, June 2005. As a result of this investigation, the Transportation Division recommends the following:

Amendment to Code Section 12-4-41 (35 MPH Traffic Zone)

Add Cedar Bend Drive from Loop 1 (MoPac Expressway) (North) East Frontage Road to Metric Boulevard

ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 12-4-41 OF THE CITY CODE TO ADD
A PORTION OF CEDAR BEND DRIVE TO THE LIST OF STREETS HAVING A
MAXIMUM SPEED LIMIT OF 35 MILES PER HOUR.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

PART 1. Section 12-4-41 (*Maximum Speed Limit of 35 Miles Per Hour*) of the City
Code is amended to add Cedar Bend Drive from Loop 1 (MoPac Expressway) (North)
East Frontage Road to Metric Boulevard

PART 2. The amendments made in this ordinance shall be incorporated in alphabetical
order and the existing subsections renumbered accordingly

PART 3. This ordinance takes effect on _____, 2006
