Public Works RECOMMENDATION FOR COUNCIL ACTION

ITEM No. 11

Subject: Authorize execution of a construction contract with LAUGHLIN-THYSSEN, LTD, Houston, TX, for the Austin Clean Water Program¹ Little Walnut-Bridgeport/Fairfield Drive Wastewater Improvements Project in the amount of \$924,546, plus a \$46,227.30 contingency, for a total contract amount not to exceed \$970,773.30.

Amount and Source of Funding: Funding in the amount of \$970,773 30 is available in the Fiscal Year 2006-2007 Capital Budget of the Austin Water Utility.



This construction contract will provide for wastewater improvements within a mostly residential area located in north Austin near North Lamar Boulevard and U.S. 183. The wastewater line that is being installed is located between Fairfield Drive and Bridgeport Drive

The improvements will replace aging and deteriorated wastewater facilities and eliminate the repeat wastewater overflows that currently occur in this area. This project is part of the Austin Water Utility's Austin Clean Water Program (ACWP), which was developed to respond to the requirements of the Environmental Protection Agency's Administrative Order regarding Sanitary Sewer Overflows

The proposed wastewater improvement consists of replacing an existing wastewater line with a total of 622 linear feet of 8-inch and 1,141 linear feet of 12-inch wastewater line. They will be installed via open-cut construction methods. There will be 39 linear feet of 8-inch wastewater line installed via a bore. Approximately 216 linear feet of the 12-inch and 39 linear feet of the 8-inch wastewater lines will be installed in the trench of the existing wastewater line. The proposed wastewater lines range in depth from 5 to 18 feet. The work will require maintaining wastewater service via bypass pumping. Sixteen new manholes will be installed and four existing manholes will be rehabilitated. Thirty wastewater service connections will be replaced and reconnected.



Bid documents were distributed to nine general contractors. Bids were opened October 5, 2006. Laughlin-Thyssen, LTD. submitted the lowest of six bids received:

The contractor's choice of work methodology provides for nine areas of subcontracting opportunities including: Pipe Supply, Boring and Hauling, Erosion Control, Surveying, Photography, Fuel, Paving, Manholes Coating, Rock Trenching.

Project specific subgoals stated in the solicitation were 6.0% African American, 12.29% Hispanic, 0.91% Native/Asian American, 5.22% WBE. Total participation estimated on base bid amount of \$924,546.00
