
The Davis Water Treatment Plant (WTP) has a rated treatment capacity of 120 million gallons per day. The plant is a conventional lime softening plant, with rapid mix basins, flocculation basins, sedimentation basins, gravity filters, clearwell storage, and raw water and finished water pumping stations. Powdered Activated Carbon is added for taste and odor control, and settled water pH is adjusted with carbon dioxide The plant was constructed in 1954 and expanded in 1961 and 1973, with additional improvements in 1986, 1993, 1997, 2000, 2002 and 2003.

Much of the existing equipment at Davis WTP has exceeded its useful life and the integrity of certain components has been compromised by corrosion and age. Turner, Collie and Braden, Inc. was selected in late 2004 to evaluate current processes and the condition of existing equipment. They recommended improvements and equipment replacement and rehabilitation including.

•piping and structural modifications in the Rapid Mix Basins •piping and sluice gate modifications in the Distribution Channels •equipment, piping and structural modifications to the Sludge Equalization system •HVAC modifications to the Chemical Building ventilation system •mechanical modifications and replacement of protective coatings on the exterior of the lime silos and structural steel located in the Chemical Building •equipment modifications to improve drainage in the Flocculation Gallery

Work is anticipated to start November 2006 and continue until June 2007.

Due to the potential for unexpected factors when constructing plant rehabilitation projects, a 5% contingency in funding has been included to allow for the expeditious processing of any change orders. The contract allows 240 calendar days for completion of this project.



Bid documents were distributed to 10 general contractors. Bids were opened September 25, 2006. Excel Construction Services, LLC submitted the lowest bid:

The contractor's choice of work methodology provides for subcontracting opportunities in seven areas which are listed below. Participation subgoals stated in the solicitation were 7.67% MBE and 4.50% WBE. Total participation estimated on base bid amount of \$2,224,000.
