Boards and Commission Action Recommended by the Austin Airport Advisory Commission

The existing West Runway 17R/35L and the parallel Taxiway C were constructed in 1957-1958 as the primary runway for Bergstrom Air Force Base. In 1995, the runway and taxiway were rehabilitated as part of the construction of the new Austin-Bergstrom International Airport. In 1997, the runway was certified and cargo operations commenced. Since passenger operations began in 1999, the West Runway has handled approximately one-half of the total commercial operations.

The purpose of this project is to provide an aircraft bypass capability at the south end of Runway 17R/35L. The current condition at Runway 35L only allows a single aircraft to access the runway for takeoff. Bottlenecks may occur when a departing aircraft approaches the runway but is not immediately ready for takeoff, and blocks runway access for subsequent departing aircraft. A bypass taxiway at this location will provide flexibility in runway use by enhancing the ground maneuverability of departing aircraft. Runway 35L is the only runway at ABIA without a bypass capability.

This is a federally funded project. The funding and budget for preliminary, final design, and construction phase services have been established. The project will be designed and constructed under active airfield conditions, therefore consideration of mitigating impacts to airport operations is critical.

The City will authorize the engineering services to be conducted in phases. Assuming satisfactory performance, the City intends to retain the selected engineering consultant for all phases of this project.

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This request allows for the development of a professional service agreement with the recommended firm Should the City be unsuccessful in negotiating a satisfactory agreement with the recommended firm, negotiations will cease with that firm. Staff will then return to Council and request authorization to begin negotiations with the alternate recommendation listed below.



Notification of issuance of a Request for Qualifications (RFQ) for the subject services was sent to 248 firms on August 2, 2006 The RFQ was obtained by 29 firms, and five firms submitted qualification statements. None of the firms were certified DBE firms. Of the five firms evaluated, three firms were short-listed and interviewed. Interviewing of the short-listed firms results in the following recommendation.

The participation goal stated in the solicitation was 21 0% DBE—Both the recommended and alternate firms provided DBE Compliance Plans that met the goals of the solicitation and were approved by the Department of Small and Minority Business Resources
