**Amount and Source of Funding:** Funding in the amount of \$291,336 is available in the Fiscal Year 2006-2007 Operating Budget of Austin Energy Funding for the remaining 15 months of the original contract period and extension options is contingent upon available funding in future budgets.

**MBE/WBE:** These contracts will be awarded in compliance with Chapter 2-9C of the City Code (Minority Owned and Women-Owned Business Enterprise Procurement Program). No subcontracting opportunities were identified, therefore, no goals were established for this solicitation

These contracts are for janitorial services at 11 Austin Energy Department locations which include Town Lake Center, Energy Control Center, Kramer Service Center Buildings C/D, Kramer Service Center Building E, St Elmo Service Center, Domain Plant, District Cooling Plant 1, District Cooling Plant 2, Holly Power Plant and the Robert Mueller Energy Center.

The purpose of having a janitorial services contract is to provide a clean and safe environment for City employees and the public. These facilities host both public and City meetings, and therefore, must be professionally cleaned and maintained. Services are divided into daily, weekly, bi-weekly, monthly and quarterly tasks that vary by site. The buildings total approximately 305,000 square feet.
