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Purchasing Office RECOMMENDATION FOR COUNCIL ACTION

ITEM No. 31

Subject: Authorize award and execution of a five-year requirements service contract with BFI Waste Services of TX, dba Allied Waste Services of TX, Del Valle, TX, for refuse and recyclable collection services in an estimated amount not to exceed \$2,904,000, with two, three-year extension options, in an estimated amount not to exceed \$1,742,400 per extension option, for a total estimated contract amount not to exceed \$6,388,800

Amount and Source of Funding: Funding in the amount of \$435,600 is available in the Fiscal Year 2006-2007 Operating Budget of the Aviation Department. Funding for the remaining 51 months of the original contract term and extension options is contingent upon available funding in future budgets.

Fiscal Note: There is no unanticipated fiscal impact. A fiscal note is not required.

Purchasing Language: Lowest bid of two bids received

MBE/WBE: This contract will be awarded in compliance with Chapter 2-9C of the City Code (Minority-Owned and Women-Owned Business Enterprise Procurement Program). No Subcontracting opportunities were identified, therefore, no goals were established for this solicitation.

This contract will provide all refuse and recyclable collection services at Barbara Jordan Terminal Facility at Austin Bergstrom International Airport including personnel and equipment necessary to collect, transport, dump, compact, and dispose of refuse and recyclable material generated from the terminal building operations and inbound aircraft.

Equipment provided includes two refuse and two recycling compactors, two dumpers, 30 refuse and recycling trash carts with wheels, and one tow vehicle. Trash carts will be strategically placed around the terminal facility and aircraft ramps and are regularly towed to the compactor site for dumping, compacting, and disposal. Carts, compactors, and compactor site areas will be cleaned and sanitized regularly and kept free of debris to assure healthy and sanitary conditions for the traveling public, tenants, and all airport users.
