

AUSTIN CITY COUNCIL MINUTES

ANNEXATION SPECIAL CALLED MEETING MONDAY, OCTOBER 30, 2006

The City Council of Austin, Texas convened in a Special Called Meeting on Monday, October 30, 2006 at the Hope Presbyterian Church, 11512 Olson Drive, Austin Texas.

Mayor Wynn called the Special Called Meeting to order at 6:50 p.m. Those present were: Mayor Wynn, and Council Members Cole, Leffingwell, and Martinez.

1. Conduct a public hearing to receive public comment on issues related to the full purpose annexation of the Anderson Mill Road annexation area (approximately 183 acres located on Anderson Mill Road approximately two thirds of a mile east of the intersection of FM 620 and Anderson Mill Road). Full purpose annexation is anticipated in December 2008 in accordance with the City's Municipal Annexation Plan. The public hearing was closed without objection.

Mayor Wynn adjourned the meeting at 7:07 p.m. without objection.

The minutes for the Special Meeting of October 30, 2006 were approved on this the 16th day of November, 2006 on Council Member McCracken's motion, Council Member Martinez' second on a 7-0 vote.
