# Council Member's Request

- Compliance of the project's site plan with the City's site plan review process
- Quality and completeness of the project's site plan
- Responsiveness to related public information requests
- Chronology of the Big Box Ordinance and its relationship to the project

### Compliance of the Site Plan

- Developer and the City were substantially in compliance with applicable laws and regulations
- Identified one exception:
  - Incomplete notice

#### **Incomplete Notice**

- City Code §25-1-133 outlines the notification requirements
- The Northcross notice did not:
  - State the earliest date that action under a decision may occur
  - Describe the procedure and requirements for becoming an interested party
- Effects

### Quality and Completeness of the Site Plan

- Determined the site plan complied with all applicable requirements
  - All documents were filed timely and all fees were paid
  - No deviations from the prescribed process
- Time constraints did not allow for a comprehensive review of the quality of the site plan

# Public Information Requests

- Two relevant PIRs received
- Evidence indicates the responses to the PIRs were complete and timely
  - Some information was exempt under the Public Information Act
  - The City appropriately sought approval from the Attorney General's Office

#### **Chronology of Events**

- Time constraints prevented the production of a complete chronology
- Verified several of the events and dates from two existing chronologies, but noted some errors
- No evidence of relationship between the progression of the Big Box Ordinance and the Northcross Mall redevelopment project

#### **Work in Progress**

■ Significantly more time required to:

- Assess the quality of the site plan
- -Further review the chronology
