

**Boards and Commission Action** Recommended by the Water and Wastewater Commission

This project is intended to replace aging and deteriorated wastewater facilities and eliminate the repeated wastewater overflows currently occurring in this area. Construction of this project is expected to occur from February 2007 to November 2007. This project is part of the Austin Water Utility's Austin Clean Water Program (ACWP), which was developed to respond to the requirements of the Environmental Protection Agency's Administrative Order regarding Sanitary Sewer Overflows.

This project includes the following work. Installation of approximately 1,210 linear feet of 21-inch PVC wastewater line within Johnson Creek beneath the Cesar Chavez/5th Street ramps on MoPac Approximately 375 feet of this line will be installed by boring. In addition, 100 feet of 18-inch PVC wastewater line will be installed. The scope of work further includes repair/restoration of the hike and bike trail adjacent to the construction area, streambank stabilization, and normal erosion controls.

The contract allows 135 working days for final project completion
