Prior Council Action •07/15/99 Council approved list of City of Austin Transportation Enhancement Applications •10/26/00 Council approved an Advance Funding Agreement with TxDOT for the Austin Crosstown Bikeway (later renamed the Lance Armstrong Bikeway) awarded by the Statewide Transportation Enhancements Program in the amount of \$3,203,163 •09/29/2006 Council authorized the negotiation and execution of an interlocal agreement with TxDOT to amend the 10/26/00 Advance Funding Agreement for the payment to TxDOT of \$63,211 13 for the construction of the bikeway in the IH-35 right-of-way

This Amendment to the Advance Funding Agreement addresses the construction of the easternmost segment of the Lance Armstrong Bikeway located between the intersection of Shady Lane and East 5th Street and the Montopolis (US Hwy 183) Bridge over the Colorado River. This segment of the bikeway is in TxDOT right-of-way. Under this agreement, TxDOT will be responsible for constructing this portion of the bikeway and the City will provide its 38% share of the \$185,000 cost (\$70,300)

Under the original agreement, the City was required to build this portion with City work forces because it was located in TxDOT's right-of-way. Recent developments indicate that TxDOT will have a construction project in this vicinity and it would be prudent to incorporate the bikeway into their highway construction contract. TxDOT has indicated that they would prefer to do the construction in order to effectively control the activities in their right-of-way.

ADVANCE FUNDING AGREEMENT AMENDMENT #2

THIS AMENDMENT IS MADE BY AND BETWEEN the State of Texas, acting through the Texas Department of Transportation, hereinafter called the State, and the City of Austin acting by and through their duly authorized officials, hereinafter called the Local Government

WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, the State and the Local Government executed a contract on 13th day of December of 2000, and amended November 1, 2005, to effectuate their agreement to complete the Austin Crosstown Bikeway Project, and,

WHEREAS, it has become necessary to amend that contract.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises and of the mutual covenants and agreements of the parties hereto, the State and the Local Government do agree as follows

AGREEMENT

Article 1 Description of Amended Items

Section 10 Construction Responsibilities Paragraph A Immediately after the last sentence of Amendment No. 1 to this agreement the following is added

The State shall construct the portion of the Project which lies within State right of way of US 183 from Shady Lane to the US 183 bridge over the Colorado River (exhibit A attached) under the State's contract with identifier CSJ 0265-01-080. The State identifier for this work shall be CSJ 0265-01-101. Prior to letting the contract for the work, the Local Government shall provide their 38% participation amount of the construction items estimated at \$185,000.00.


All other provisions of the original contract are unchanged and remain in full force and effect
