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During the Council orientation, there was a request for a full list of the Intergovernmental Bodies to which Council Members are appointed. Attached is the list of current members for each Intergovernmental Body, along with an explanation of how the body is comprised and if a specific requirement exists for the appointment (i.e. the Mayor is required by statute to sit on a specific Intergovernmental Body).

The list is also color-coded by urgency and is designated as follows:

- Any listing highlighted in yellow means it is critical an appointment be made within the next 30 days as the bodies will take up critical business and representation of the City of Austin would be needed;
- Any listing in blue means that the appointment should be made within 30-60 days;
- Any listing in green means that the appointment should be made within 60-90 days.
