SUBJECT: Chief Equity Officer Recruiting Update

The purpose of this memorandum is to provide an update on staff's progress with the recruitment of the Chief Equity Officer for the City of Austin and to invite you to attend the town hall meeting.

The application deadline for the Chief Equity Officer ended on June 3, 2016. The executive recruiting firm leading the search process, The Hawkins Company, as well as a team from the City Manager's Office has identified the top four candidates that will participate in panel interviews and a town hall meeting on Thursday, August 25, 2016 at the Palmer Events Center. We wanted to take this opportunity to outline that process.
