SUBJECT:	Resolution No. 20121108-053: Veteran's Business Enterprise Program

On November 8, 2012, Council passed Resolution No. 20121108-053 directing the City Manager to include veteran business enterprises in the disparity study analysis and upon completion of that analysis to present to Council a program that would promote meaningful business opportunities. This memo serves as an update on the development of a Veteran's Business Enterprise Program.

The Small & Minority Business Resources Department (SMBR) has been actively researching other veteran's business programs across the nation for best practices. Currently, there are four municipalities (San Antonio, Boston, Indianapolis, and Chicago) that have programs based on veteran status.

As you may recall, the disparity study includes information related to the availability of Veteran Business Enterprises and included information related to their use on City contracts. Based on the information included in the disparity study, SMBR is working with the Purchasing Office, Capital Contracting Office and the Law Department to create a program framework that will meet the needs of the impacted community as well as meet the requirements of State procurement law. SMBR and CCO also attended the Commission of Veterans Affairs April meeting to gather input on a potential program.

program framework to the Commission with the goal of receiving meaningful feedback so as to
further refine the framework.
