SUBJECT: Rider Ordinance to advance to Council; other micro-mobility changes still

The rider behavior ordinance shared with the Mobility Committee will advance for Council review and approval on March 28, to expedite the education and enforcement of people's behaviors using bicycles and scooters.

Additional time is needed for the Austin Transportation Department to thoroughly respond to ideas and questions raised by the City Council Mobility Committee and stakeholders on the three ordinances related to micro-mobility devices. It is anticipated these ordinances will be presented to Council later this spring.

The three ordinances and issues still under development include:

- The City's authority to regulate Shared Micro-Mobility Services in the public right of way;
- Administrative fees for processing, monitoring, and licensing the use of right of way; and,
- Franchise creation standards and limitations.
