SUBJECT:	Shared Mobility Program Update

The purpose of this memorandum is to provide an update on the Shared Mobility Program and Austin Transportation Department (ATD) staff's recommendations for Council action.

ATD is updating and enhancing the current shared micro-mobility program to provide a comprehensive set of recommendations intended to incorporate all current and future shared mobility services that vend in the City of Austin's Right-of-Way. This program will not include Transportation Network Companies (TNCs), which are regulated by the State of Texas.

In a <u>June 2019 Memo to Mayor and Council</u>, we indicated our intent to return to Council for consideration this month (September). While we were poised to report back to Council in September, new direction from Council during the budget process asked that we incorporate the funding options, working with our providers. It is our intention to provide an integrated programmatic, capital investment and funding proposal to Council in October.
