SUBJECT: Changes to APD General Orders - City Council Resolution No. 20200611-050

The purpose of this memorandum is to report changes to APD General Orders per Resolution No. <u>20200611-050</u> that requires "All changes to General Orders must be reported back to the Council and relevant Council committees as they are implemented."

APD's General Orders (GO) are located on the City's <u>website</u>. All changes made to GOs will be posted on this website with the redline version so that Council and the public may view the changes made to the policies. The following GOs were changed on the dates indicated:

Separately, Council Resolution No. <u>20200611-095</u>, provided specific direction that GO revisions related to Use of Tear Gas, Use of Force, Chokehold Use, Military Equipment, No-Knock Warrants, Facial Recognition, and Acoustic Devices, be made in an open process that is facilitated by the Office of Police Oversight, and includes feedback from the community, Council Committees, and Council, prior to implementation. Revisions to these polices will be posted to the website after completion of the process.
