**SUBJECT:** Selected grantees for outreach contracts for Relief of Emergency Needs for Tenants

This memorandum is provided as backup for item 21 on the September 17, 2020 City Council agenda. The item is to ratify a master agreement with multiple grantees to provide outreach for COVID-19 impacted households who are in need of emergency rental assistance through the Relief for Emergency Needs of Tenants (RENT) Program.

Item 21: Ratify a master agreement with multiple grantees to provide emergency outreach for COVID-19 impacted households who are in need of emergency rental assistance through the Relief for Emergency Needs of Tenants program, not to exceed \$400,000 for the term of August 17, 2020 through December 31, 2020.

These grants will expand outreach to vulnerable populations facing ongoing financial hardship due to COVID-19 by supporting community-based organizations that have a demonstrated record of success reaching out to the focus populations. Grants to qualifying organizations will not exceed \$50,000 per organization. The recommended award are a result of a Request for Applications and evaluation process led in partnership with the City of Austin Equity Office.

## The focus population for the outreach are:

- Low-income residents in zip codes with high rates of COVID-19
- African American/Black and Latinx(a/o)
- Large households or families with children
- People with disabilities
- Veterans
- People with Limited English Proficiency
