SUBJECT: Aquatic Division Operational Status Update

The purpose of this memorandum is to provide an update regarding maintenance and staffing associated with the Austin Parks and Recreation Department's (Department) aquatic facilities and programming for the 2021 summer swim season.

AQUATIC MAINTENANCE

All aquatic facilities received damage from Winter Storm Uri. The repair schedule was impacted by requirements for lead and asbestos testing and availability of parts and contractors to help assist with the completion of repairs. Due to these issues the Aquatic Division strategically planned a phase approach for repair efforts. The focus of repairs was first centered on the year-round swimming pools and then to the pools where lifeguard training courses were being conducted. Next on the priority list are all other aquatic facilities.

While the Aquatic Division staff and contractors have worked diligently to get the aquatic facilities repaired and ready for the summer, some facilities still have repair needs. In accordance with standard City practices, one facility is still in need of lead and asbestos testing. Another facility requires lead and asbestos abatement before repairs can be made. Both processes add to the repair timeline.

Aquatic Facilities in need of Winter Storm Uri repairs and not in operations include:

- Bailey Splash Pad
- Canyon Vista Pool
- Dick Nichols Pool
- Martin Pool (awaiting lead and asbestos abatement)
- Mary Baylor Clarksville Splash Pad
- Murchison Pool (awaiting lead and asbestos testing)
- Northwest Pool
- Reed Pool
- Westenfield Pool

Dove Spring Pool is currently closed and is undergoing a roof replacement project to the two bathhouses and pump room. The project is due to the damages from a May 2020 storm. The Department has experienced delays associated with onboarding the Job Order Contract (JOC) and the limitation of available wood supplies needed to rebuild the wood trusses. It is anticipated this project will be completed sometime in mid-July to early August.

SPLASH PADS AND SWIMMING POOLS

Utilizing available staff resources, the Aquatic Division continues to operate with modified hours of operation. Expanding hours and opening additional pools will not be possible until enough lifeguards can be trained, certified, and hired. As you are aware, the City stopped hiring lifeguards in March 2020 due to COVID-19, and staff were unable to resume hiring/training lifeguards until March 2021. Currently, the Aquatic Division has 219 lifeguards on payroll. To ensure all Austinites have access to guarded pools and aquatic programming, the Aquatic Division has developed a tiered opening schedule, based upon the number of lifeguard staff needed to operate the facilities, with estimated opening dates.

It is important to note, in recent years, the Aquatic Division has successfully been able to hire and train lifeguards due in part to a combination of efforts including but not limited to the living wage, hiring process improvements, the Swim ATX program and expanded recruiting. The lack of trained lifeguard personnel is a direct result of operational modifications necessary during the pandemic. This personnel challenge is not unique to the City of Austin, but nevertheless is disruptive to summer recreation.

AQUATIC PROGRAMMING

The Aquatic Division resumed swimming lessons on June 7, 2021, swim team will resume on June 14, 2021. Unlike lessons with our former training agency, The American Red Cross, lessons with Starfish Aquatics are skill based, rather than age based. The curriculum focuses solely on the individual being able to complete benchmarks and removes the expectation that all children of the same age have the same abilities.
