## To be eligible to participate, please follow these guidelines

- Animals must be at least 3 lbs and 3 months old to be spayed or neutered.
- Line starts at 6am, pet check-in starts at 8am.
- Do not feed your pet after midnight prior to surgery.
- Bring your pet on a leash or in a carrier.
- Pick your pet up the same day between 4:45 and 5:30pm.

## Other low-cost services available 10am-4pm

\*Low cost services include: de-worming, flea and tick prevention, Dhpp and Bordatella vaccines and heartworm test for dogs, Fvrpc, Felv vaccines and Feline leukemia/Feline AIDS test for cats.
