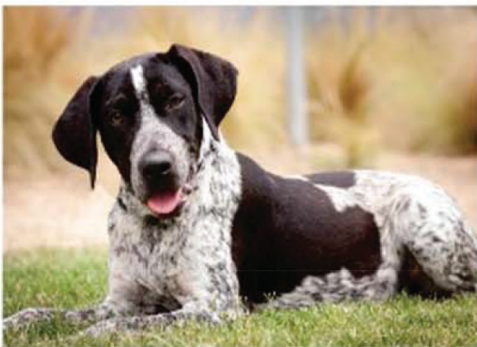

To be eligible for free spay/neuter, please follow these guidelines

- Animals must be at least 3 lbs. and 3 months old to be spayed or neutered
- Line starts at 6 AM, pet check-in starts at 8 AM
- Do not feed your pet after midnight prior to surgery.
- Bring your pet on a leash or in a carrier.
- Pick your pet up the same day at 5 PM.

Other low-cost services available 10 AM-4 PM

*Low cost services include: de-worming, flea and tick prevention, Dhpp and Bordatella vaccines and heartworm test for dogs, Fvrpc, Felv vaccines and feline leukemia/Feline AIDS tests for cats.
