Notes About the Cat Numbers

February, like January, was another challenging month for stray and free-roaming cats. Twenty-one cats came in with severe trauma injuries, with most of those injuries being likely attributable to them having been hit by a car. Eighteen of these cats were humanely euthanized, while three more passed away under our care. Three cats who were diagnosed with feline leukemia, along with one who was diagnosed with feline immunodeficiency virus, were suffering from severe symptoms stemming from these and concomitant illnesses. Several more were suffering from severe injuries of unknown origins. Overall, 26 were humanely euthanized, and six passed away under our care.
