

How to Adopt a Foster Pet

Thank you for your interest in adopting an animal from foster care. Unless the foster care provider's contact information is provided in the animal's description on the website, please complete and submit the visitor profile found [HERE](#) or visit Austin Animal Center to create a visitor profile with one of our customer service staff members. Once we have your information in our database, we can provide you with the foster parent's e-mail address so that you may contact them for further information.

Please keep in mind that pets in our foster program are not available on a first come, first served basis. The foster care provider may speak and/or meet with several potential adopters before deciding which home would be the best fit for that particular animal. Also, there are times when our records are not up to date, as there can be a delay between the foster care provider finding placement for an animal and that information being communicated to us. Because of this, animals listed as available on the website may actually already be spoken for and you will need to contact the foster care provider for the current status of the animal(s) that you are interested in.

The adoption fees for animals in foster care are as follows:

Puppies/Dogs (under one year of age)	\$75
Kittens/Cats (under seven years of age)	\$35 each OR \$40 for a bonded pair
Dogs (between one and six years of age)	\$35
Senior Dogs/Cats (seven years age and older)	No fee
