Animal Advisory Commission Public Communication and Speaker Sign-Up

Public comment will be allowed in-person or remotely via telephone. Speakers may only register to speak on an item once either in-person or remotely and will be allowed up to three minutes to provide their comments. Registration no later than noon the day before the meeting is required for remote participation by telephone.

General Public Communication: the first 10 speakers signed up prior to the meeting being called to order will each be allowed a three-minute allotment to address their concerns regarding items **not** posted on the agenda.

Speaker Sign-up: any speakers signed up to speak prior to the meeting being called to order will each be allowed a three-minute allotment to address items on the agenda for which they registered.

Members of the public who register to speak regarding agenda items will be called after General Public Communication and prior to any agenda items being taken up. Speakers will be called up by agenda item. Registered speakers will be allowed to speak for three minutes per item registered for unless voted to reduce time.

The rules and procedures were approved by the Animal Advisory Commission at the regular meeting held on December 12, 2022.
