ABOUT:

The Invitation for Bid process is a method of procuring construction services. The Invitation for Bid solicitation method is prescribed by State Statute 252.043(d) which states "... the contract must be awarded to the lowest responsible bidder ... and the "Bidder's past experience and safety record may be considered."

Bidding Process:

- Plans and project specifications are advertised
- Pre-Bid Conference is held
- Lowest responsive, responsible bidder is determined taking into account:
 - City's MBE/WBE Program
 - Bidder's Experience see below Statement of Bidder's Experience Section 00400
- Bidder's Safety Experience Section 00410 is reviewed
- Council considers and approves bid award
- Contracts developed and executed

Statement of Bidder's Experience - Section 00400

For the City to determine the apparent three (3) low Bidders are responsive, responsible bidders must submit:

- Experience Requirements (General Contractor)
- Project Manager and Superintendent Experience
- Experience Requirements (include Subcontractors for specific construction or technical experience)
- Available Equipment
- Available Workforce
- Current and Completed Projects
- Past Performance on City Projects
