 No work may begin prior to issuance of this permit. It is important to verify with the Development Assistance Center (DAC) that new construction will be permitted on the property at this location PRIOR to filing this application. If the structure to be demolished is currently tied into water and/or sewer services provided by the City of Austin, you must contact Austin Water Utility at 512-494-9400 to obtain specific water and sewer service information. Erosion and Sedimentation Controls are required per Section 25-8-181 of the City of Austin Land Development Code. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in a Stop Work Order and/or legal action by the City of Austin including criminal charges and fines of up to \$2,000.00 per day. 4a. Inspection of erosion, sedimentation controls, and tree protection shall be requested by the owner before construction begins (25-1-288.A & 25-1-288.F): (512) 974-2278 or environmental.inspections@austintexas.gov. If the proposed work will require use of City right-of-way, a Right of Way Application must be approved prior to any such activity. Applications may be obtained from the City of Austin Transportation Department (512-974-7180) or on the website at austintexas.gov/rowman. The Historic Preservation Office will review this application to determine if the structure that is subject of this application is potentially historic as defined by Section 25-11-214 of the City of Austin Land Development Code. Additional review by the Historic Landmark Commission may be required and additional fees may be assessed. All demolition permitted commercial and multifamily projects are required to divert construction debris from the landfill (LDC 25-11-39)." Once this review is complete and approved, the permit may be obtained from the Permit Center and additional fees will be assessed at that time.
